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Introduction

Thanks for getting your copy of ***“Supreme YouTube Monopoly”***. In this guide, I’m going to show you how I have been able to boost my videos or comments to the top by being able to get an unlimited number of likes, favorites, subscribers and more... right from YouTube. The secret I’m about to unveil to you is something I haven’t seen anyone do before so I’m glad to share it with you today, as you will be among a small number of people to get advantage of it from the very beginning.

This might be one of the most straight-to-the-point guides you ever get your hands on, as I’m all for saving time, both mine and yours. So, with no further ado, let’s get started right away!

The Method

So, what is this method about? It’s about a recent change made to YouTube that is going to be very beneficial when used in the right way. If you remember, back in the days if you had a channel on YouTube and that you wanted to create another channel for another purpose, you needed to create a brand new YouTube, thus Google account. But recently in 2013, this was no longer the case, and with this update you can now create a seemingly unlimited number of channels on YouTube **‘from a single account’**, and This Is Big! WHY? Because the principles haven’t changed. By that I mean even though you are using for example 3 different channels from the same account, from the indexing bots’ point-of-view it’s like you are using 3 different accounts. Let me tell you about the benefits so that you can have a better idea of what I’m talking about.

- I- One of the most effective and common ways to get your video ranked is by getting a lot of interactions to your video, and by interactions I mean likes, comments, subscribers, shares and so

on... Where will those interactions come from? Answer: they will be coming from other YouTube users. These YouTube users can be interacting with your video using their initial profile as a channel, or using a specific channel they have created, and the result will be the same.

II- Now let's go to YouTube (YT) and let me show you something:

Here we are at the comments section of a random YT video. Notice the area highlighted in the red rectangle (Top Comments)? This means YT always show the top comments by default, and those are the ones which get interacted with and this can happen in 2 ways:

- Liking and disliking the comment (Yes, dislikes are also part of interactions)
- Replying the comment.

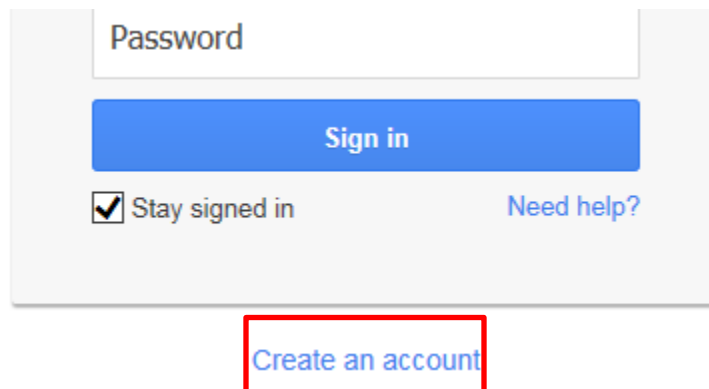
But either way, those interactions which have the potential to boost your videos or comments to the top would be coming from other YouTube accounts/channels, and the big question is: WHAT IF YOU WERE THOSE OTHER CHANNELS? This course will be about the power of **'Self-Interactions'**. You will be creating brand new channels (in under a minute if you want) and using those channels to interact with our videos or comments in order to boost them to the first page.

Talking about inter**actions**, let's get ready to take **actions**!

For the purpose of this course I will be creating a brand new Google account, which I suggest you do as well. Just go to Google.com and click on the blue button 'Sign in' *at the top-right corner*

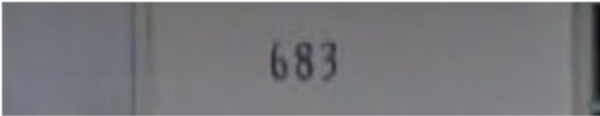

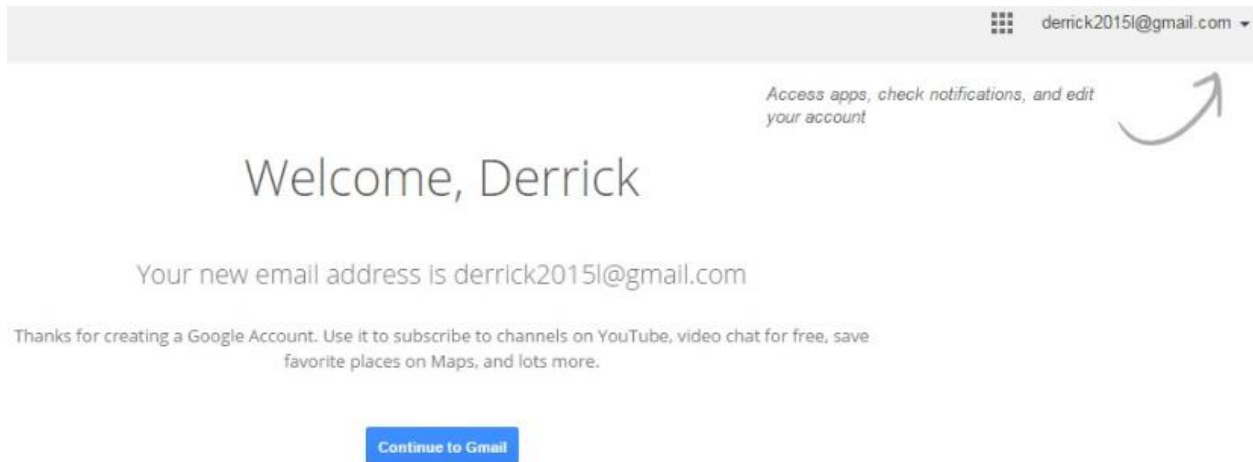

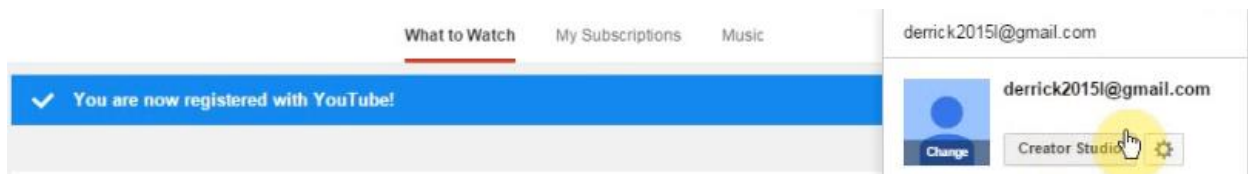

Now that your new account has been created and that you are already signed-in, you can go straight to YouTube.com and click 'Sign in' at the top right corner.



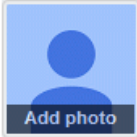
You are now registered to YouTube

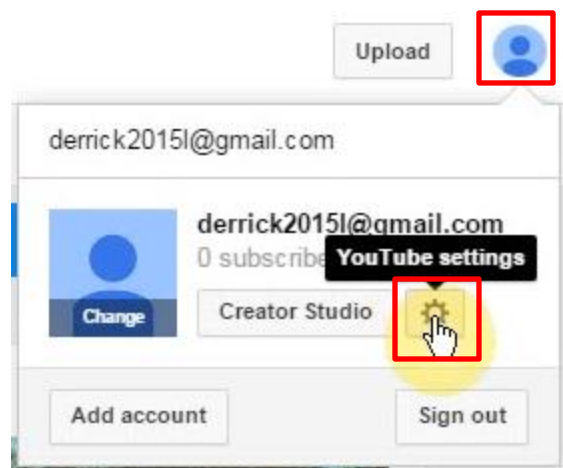

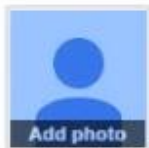

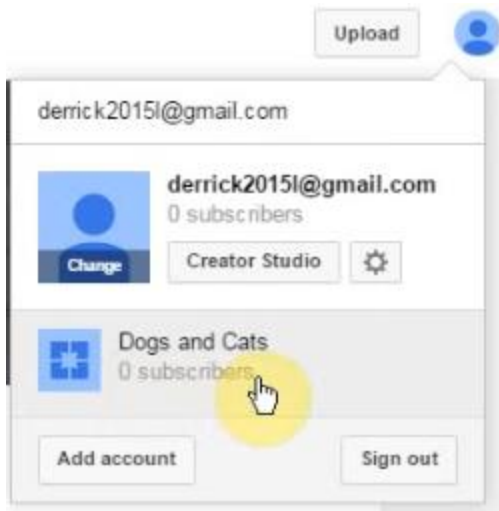

Now your new channel has been created and when you go to the list you see it and click on it to select it. You can repeat the same process again and again to create more channels.

From the second channel that you will be creating, things will look a little bit different. Let's go over it. Click on the little YT setting gear again and you will be taking to the same page, but instead of just 'Create a new channel' you will see 'See all my channels or create a new channel'

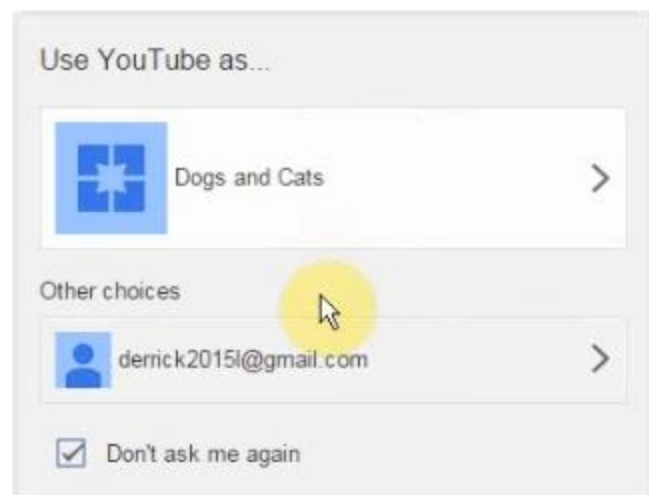

The rest of the process will be the same. After you finish creating the second channel you might be presented this box in order to choose which channel you want to use now. I usually tick the 'Don't ask me again' box because I can switch channels easily when I need



to, that's your choice. If one of your newly created channels is selected, then when you click on 'See all my channels or create a new channel', you will see the channels' list like this

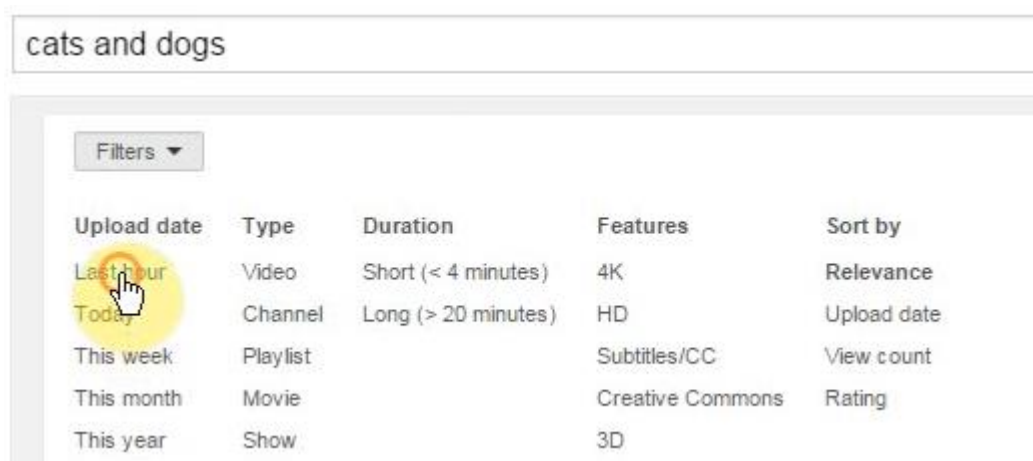


To continue creating another channel, just click the first big rectangle button 'Create a new channel'. I will be creating 3 more. Now that you have your channels created we will go over live usage of the method.

Boosting Videos

As mentioned earlier, one of the most effective ways to rank up your video is by getting interactions to it, and I'm going to show you how to use the method to do that.

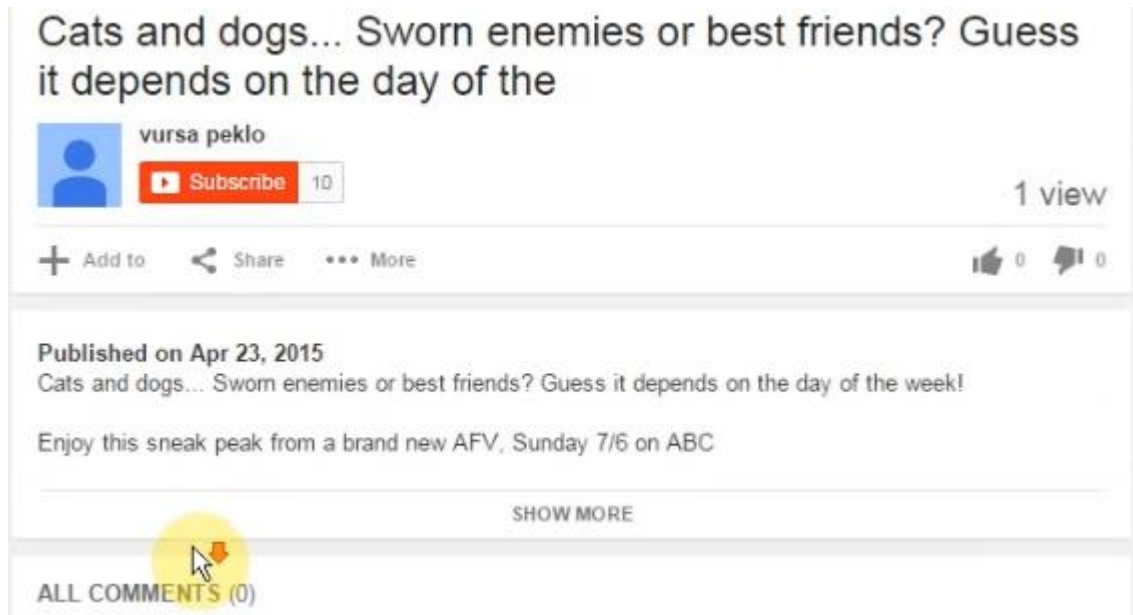
For the purpose of this illustration, let me go to YT and type anything like *"cats and dogs"*, and I will choose one of the most recently uploaded videos by selecting 'last hour' from the filter



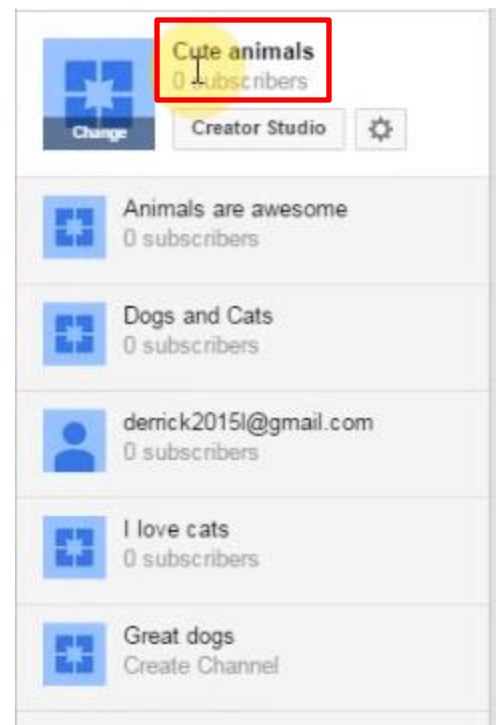
I will choose this video which was uploaded just 44 minutes ago



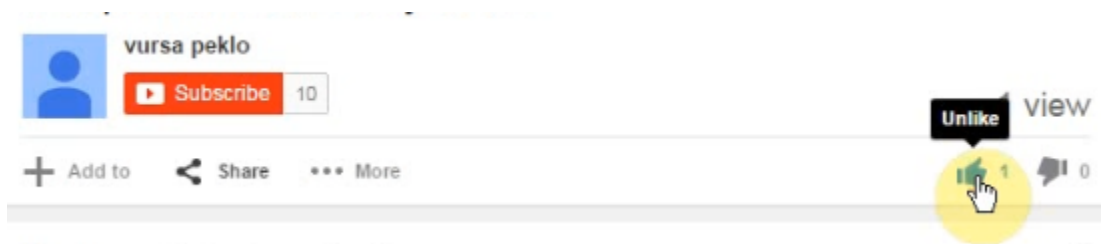
This video currently has only 1 view with no comments and no likes



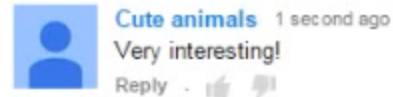
Supposing that this is my own video and that I want to boost it, I'm going to self-interact with it using the 5 accounts/channels that I have created. Click on the top-right profile picture icon to see the channels list. Make sure you have selected the one you want to use; the one which is currently selected will be at the top, and as you can see I have selected the channel 'Cute animals'.



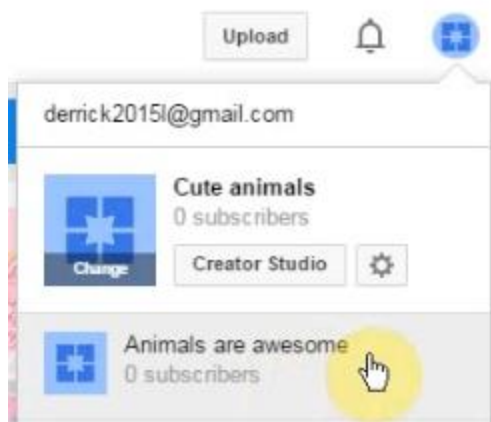
Now you can just go ahead and *Like* the video



The same way, you can also leave a comment. As you can see, my comment was posted 1 sec ago.



You can do anything else like subscribing, sharing, adding to Favorites and so on... Now we are going to give the video another Like for which we will need to switch to another channel. I know you might be thinking this will be a painful or time-consuming task because you will need to open a new tab/window, sign-out and sign-in again, re-launch your browser or even



restart your computer. But don't worry! None of that will be required, and it will be as simple and quick as clicking the top-right profile icon again to display the channels list, and just clicking on the next channel you want to be using, and Bingo! The page will just reload with the newly chosen channel in use.

I click on Like again and now I have 2 Likes. I will go ahead and give the video 2 more Likes using 2 other channels. Just to confirm that everything is going smoothly, I will copy the video link and paste it on another browser where I have signed-in with another Google account. And as you can see below, all my Likes and comments have been registered

Boosting Comments

The exact same strategy applies to boosting comments, which consists in liking/disliking and replying the comment. Let me choose another 'cats and dogs' video

I will leave a comment using the 'Cute animals' channel. To Like the comment, simply click on the 'thumb up' icon. Most people would wait

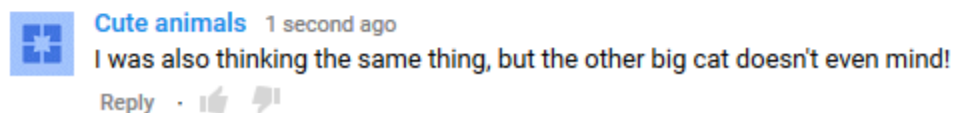
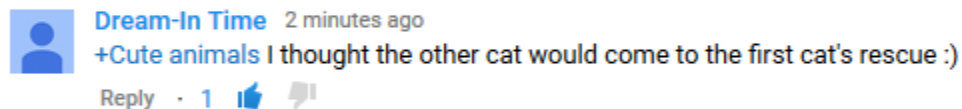


for the Like to come from someone else while they can also Like their own video or comment, and this single self-Like can be powerful enough to boost you up the first comments page, so don't hesitate to do it.

To give your comment another Like, just follow the same process that you did in the previous section.



Now to comment on your comment (self-replying your comment), you can either use the same channel you've used for the initial comment, or you can just use another channel. To do so, just click on 'Reply' below the comment

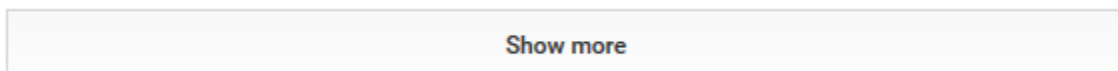
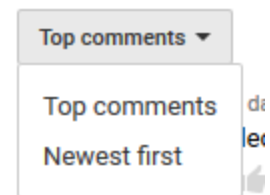


As you can see, I did both. I used the 'Dream-In Time' channel to give the second like to the initial comment and to leave the first reply. Chances are, even if there were to be 100 more comments from other users, this comment block will stay in the first comments page. And this is at a glance how this method works! As with the videos, you can continue liking and replying to boost your comment to the top.

Tips & Conclusion

This is exactly how I have been able to boost my videos and comments to the top without using any third-party software or social media services. A few tips worth mentioning:

- I recommend creating a new Google/YouTube account (and no more than one) in order to apply the method used in this course.
- Do not interact heavily with your video at once (for example 10 Likes in one minute), but spread the interactions over time.
- Do not give your comment many likes right after you've posted it. This can cause other users to mark it as spam.
- Some of you might be confused when I'm telling about the *first comment page*, so to be clear, I will quickly tell you what I consider as being the first comment page. Whenever you load a video on YouTube, when you scroll down to the commenting section you will see 'Top Comments'. If you click on it you will see the option 'Newest first'. This let us know that YouTube display the comments which get the most interactions first. But if there are say, 100 comments on a video, not all of them will be displayed at once. A few will be displayed (a block), then you will need to click on 'Show more' at the bottom to see the remaining ones block by block.



I consider each comment block as a comment page, and each time you click on 'Show more' you go to the next comment page. I hope it's clear now. And the truth is, many viewers will scroll down the first comment page, then leave; and this is where you will find this method useful, as it will allow you to reach the first comment page/block.

- Lastly, I would also recommend opening a New private window or tab each time you are going to use the dedicated account that you have created for this method.
